OK, OK, OK – I will keep "The List". But, I need help from all of you to help find people that have never been found, re-lost people and new people. Contact your WSPG/WSMR friends and make sure they have updated me with their information. You people from the 70's, 80's, 90's and 00's need to get cracking on finding your friends. If all you have is a list of names and the year they

would have graduated from high school, then fine – that’s a start. If you know the parents names – send that along as well.

On the left hand side (column “B”) of “The List” has a single number. That number represents the last digit of the year I received any update from that individual or family. (2=2002, 4=2004, 7=1997.) I need to get rid of the 7’s, 0’s as well as the 2’s and 3’s. The younger generations need to come up with lists or books. I know during the later years, the WSMR School produces year books. (Each of you periodically needs to go to the web page – “The List” page and resubmit your information. I spend a lot of time trying to find people that have moved, changed their phone number or area code and/or changed their email address.)

If we succeed in finding a new committee including some locals – then there will be another reunion in the future. If not – then it is a done deal.

Well, I need to cut this off. As most of you know, I have poured my heart into this project for 15 years and I seemingly could write forever. I really enjoyed my time on the base and have many great memories – too many to record. (At the time I left WSMR, I had spent almost half of my life there.) The Teen Club, dating (especially Officers daughters), scooters, dodging MP’s, working in the bowling alley – working in the commissary – throwing papers – mowing lawns – my first accident, Boy Scouts (even though I never made it past Tenderfoot), being in a base play (Damn Yankees) with my entire family including the dog and many more.

One last thing - BRICKS
